Great Rack **Here's a magazine rack that's also a design feature**

Ever noticed how magazines flop into disarray every time you pull one from the shelf? *Schlump*, like a pack of dominoes. This magazine rack, as with all great design, solves this problem with the simplest solution: it shifts the angle of storage away from the vertical to 45 degrees. Remove a magazine from this portable rack, and the rest of your copies of *Men's Health Living* remain perfectly intact.

This clever new piece of furniture is one of architect Aram Lello's works. Its genius stems from the fact that it combines functionality with great design. It's a shelf that's terribly easy on the eye; it can stand alone or be stacked to fill a wall, where it forms an eye-catching geometric design; plus it's got a handle at the apex, making it easy to pick up and move about your home. Get more than one and you can turn a shelf into a design feature, fitting the different forms together like a puzzle.

"Today magazines are treated like books, collected and read and reread. I wanted to create a dynamic storage solution," says Aram who, when he's not designing sharp furniture, works for architectural firm DHK. The shelves are made from clear perspex or wood, which comes in black or orange.
